2. I have £20. I buy 3 items costing £4.99 each. How much is left?

3. A shop offers 3 items for £6, or individually at £2.50 each. How much is saved with the offer?

4. Convert £15.75 to pence.

5. Two items together cost £9.40. One costs £5.65. How much does the other cost?
