



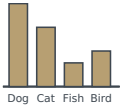
These questions cover reading and interpreting pictograms, bar charts and tables, taught during Year 3. No calculators.

4. A table shows: Monday 5 goals, Tuesday 8 goals, Wednesday 3 goals. Which day had the most?

5. How many goals were scored on Monday and Wednesday altogether?

6. How many more goals on Tuesday than Wednesday?
