

**Section A: Multi-Step Decimal Problems**

1. £8.00 ($3.45 + 2.60 + 1.95$)
2. £6.25 ($20 - 13.75$)
3. 0.5kg ($0.75 \times 2 = 1.5\text{kg}$ used, $2 - 1.5 = 0.5\text{kg}$ left)
4. 1.9m ($3.6 - 0.85 - 0.85$)
5. 5.5 ($4.5 + 5.5 = 10$)

Section B: Reasoning

1. $\frac{3}{4}$ is bigger ($\frac{3}{4} = 0.75$, which is more than 0.7)
2. Any two values from 5.5-6.4, e.g. 5.6 and 6.4
3. $\frac{1}{2}$, 0.65, $\frac{3}{4}$, 0.8
4. Because 2.5 is 2 ones and 5 tenths; two lots of 5 tenths make 1 whole, so $2.5 + 2.5 = 5$ ones exactly
5. 4.25 litres ($1.8 + 1.8 + 0.65$)
