5. A pictogram shows 1 picture = 2 pets. Sam has 3 pictures. How many pets?

6. On the same pictogram, Priya has 5 pictures. How many pets?

7. Who has more pets, Sam or Priya?

8. How many pets do Sam and Priya have altogether?
