Section A: The Anglo-Saxons

1. 5th century AD
2. Northern Europe (modern-day Germany, Denmark, and the Netherlands)
3. e.g. "England" (from "Angle-land")
4. e.g. jewellery, or weapons
5. Paganism (Anglo-Saxon paganism)

Section B: The Vikings

1. Scandinavia (modern-day Norway, Sweden, and Denmark)
2. Raiding, trading, and transporting settlers
3. e.g. Yorkshire, or East Anglia
4. The Danelaw
5. Accept a reasonable similarity (e.g. both were skilled seafarers/settlers) and difference (e.g. Vikings were initially known more for raiding)
